## **Campus Salvations**

As we seek to serve those in need and take the gospel to our city, God has continued to open doors on several local college campuses. Every week, volunteer and staff members of our outreach team go to UTSA, SAC, and Northwest Vista, among others. They share the gospel, distribute Bibles, and pray with students. There has been an incredible response. As we've talked with students one thing has been constant, an openness to the good news of Jesus, and we praise the Lord for that! In 2024 alone, 5,779 students were reached with the gospel, 1,570 Bibles were passed out, and 77 students received salvation!
